

## ST HELENA IMMIGRATION SERVICE

## **Welcome to St Helena**

The St Helena Immigration Service is located in the middle of the town at Police Headquarters, Coleman House, Jamestown.

All Crew are to complete an Arrival Declaration card upon arrival to the island. **Sections 1** to **11** on the **front** of the card and **section B** numbers **14** to **17** on the back of the card. (The Arrival card will be given at the Immigration Office, or Police Headquarters)

The Master of the vessel is to complete a yacht arrival declaration.

All passports presented should have more than 6 month's validity remaining on them.

All persons on board should have adequate medical insurance to cover emergency medical costs, including evacuation, for the duration of their visit.

Medical insurance must have a maximum cover limit of at least £175,000 for emergency medical treatment including evacuation.

If persons are not covered by insurance or cannot provide details, they are required to purchase one locally.

All persons intending to remain in St Helena for more than 72 hours are required to pay a landing fee of £20.00 (Twenty Pounds) per person.

St Helena Immigration accepts Us Dollars, Euros and South African Rand.

If arrival is on weekends, yachts should still present themselves to Police Headquarters to complete paper work. They will therefore be told to return to the Immigration Office on Monday morning for completion of formalities.
